
Driving Directions

After entering the City of Richland, proceed north on George Washington Way up the small hill just past Hanford High School.

Turn right (east) on 1st St. at the top of the hill.

Then turn right (south) onto University Drive and proceed down the hill towards the Consolidated Information Center building, the first building on the left.

Note: We are located on the Washington State University Tri-Cities campus and are accessible via the Ben Franklin Transit route 26.

About Us

The Consolidated Information Center Libraries is a collaboration of Washington State University Tri-Cities Max E. Benitz Memorial Library, Business Information Center, Hanford Technical Library, and Department of Energy's Public Reading Room.

Together they offer a broad range of print and electronic resources to the general public, students, and researchers.

The Hanford Technical Library and the Public Reading Room are functions of the Pacific Northwest National Laboratory which is operated by Battelle for the U.S. Department of Energy.

What you will find

Once you arrive at the Consolidated Information Center, you will find a professional staff to help you navigate the array of resources available through a unique collaboration of libraries—all under a single roof and open to the public.

Resources

The Hanford Technical Library and the Washington State University Tri-Cities Max E. Benitz Library resources include:

- scientific journals
- technical reports
- monographs and curriculum materials
- databases
- reference books
- standards

The Department of Energy Public Reading Room houses a collection of materials primarily related to the Hanford Site.

You will also find the Business LINKS office, in the Business Information Center, which provides information, education, training, and counseling for start-up and established businesses.

Pacific Northwest National Laboratory staff, Hanford Site staff, and Washington State University Tri-Cities faculty, staff,

and students have access to a variety of additional services such as the ability to check out materials, obtain assistance in locating resources, and order materials from other libraries.

Comfort & Convenience

Facilities include individual study carrels, tables for quiet group study, and comfortable reading areas.

Microfiche readers and coin-operated photocopiers are available for public use.

Wireless access is available through the WSU Tri-Cities network. To obtain wireless authorization, visit Computer Services located on the second floor of the Consolidated Information Center, Room 225.
